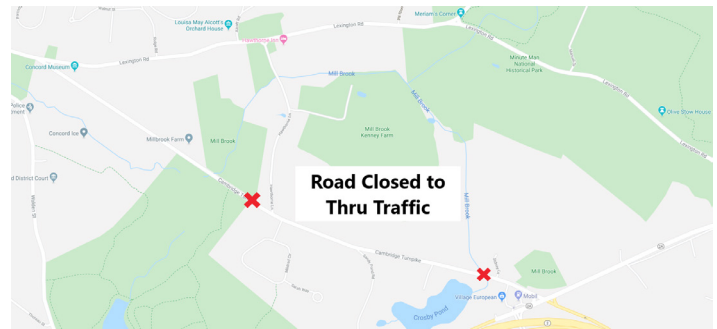

### Concord Historical Commission's 2020 Preservation Awards program

The Concord Historical Commission (CHC) invites nominations for the 2020 CHC Preservation Awards. This program is aimed at recognizing property owners, architects, contractors, local organizations, and individuals for their contributions to maintaining and enhancing the architectural, historical, and cultural heritage of the Town of Concord. Projects must have been completed between 2017 and 2019. Only exterior projects will be considered. Nomination forms are due by February 28, 2020. The 2020 Preservation Awards ceremony will be held on May 19, 2020 at the Trinitarian Congregational Church in Concord, MA. Eleni Glekas, the Director of Historic Preservation at the Boston Architectural College, will serve as the keynote speaker at the awards ceremony.
