

The Public Works Commission Has Declared a State of Water Supply Conservation

LAWN WATERING RESTRICTION

Due to an extended period of extreme heat and lack of precipitation, customer demand has reached the limits of our available water supply. To curtail water use, the following mandatory **LAWN WATERING RESTRICTION** has been put in place until further notice.

Lawn Watering – Restricted to 1 day per week

Find your watering day at www.concordma.gov/wateringday

You can still hand water your flower beds, shrubs, foundation plantings and vegetable gardens.

This restriction requires all residential and commercial customers served by Concord Water to reduce lawn watering to 1 day per week, **effective immediately**. Please adjust your irrigation controller accordingly to avoid issuance of a lawn watering ban. If you do not know how to adjust your controller, contact your irrigation professional for assistance.

Please be advised that Concord Public Works is monitoring customer demand and available water supply around the clock and will provide additional information as it becomes available.
