FOSSIL FUEL INFRASTRUCTURE: CONFIRM AUTHORIZATION TO APPLY FOR FOSSIL FUEL-FREE DEMONSTRATION PROJECT PARTICIPATION

Motion: That the Town take affirmative action on Article 1 as printed in the Warrant

Affirmative Action Recommended by: Select Board

Reason: Non-controversial at hearing; furthers affirmative vote under Article 31 of 2021 Annual Town Meeting by confirming authorization for Select Board to apply for state program authorizing certain towns to adopt a bylaw limiting expansion of fossil fuel infrastructure and amending bylaw approved under same Article 31 to conform to state program.

Affirmative Action Recommended by: Community Preservation Committee; Finance Committee, Select Board

Reason: Routine action to rescind prior Community Preservation Fund appropriations for Community Housing unused due to project cancellation and to appropriate those funds to the Community Housing Reserve Fund to be held for future town meeting appropriation for Community Housing projects upon CPC recommendation; non-controversial at hearing.
