PROJECT UPDATES



Nagog Pond Project Update No. 1 – Week of March 10th

- The Town of Concord provides Nagog Pond Project updates via a Google Group that serve as an e-mail subscription for distribution of information regarding the project, via <https://groups.google.com/g/nagog-project-updates>
- The Nagog Pond Project is being constructed by the Town of Concord's General Contractor (D&C Constriction Company of Weymouth, MA). Work is anticipated to continue through mid-May 2023.

Construction Activities

- During the week of March 3rd, erosion controls were installed along the perimeter of the Nashoba Road staging area, and mobilization of pond access equipment inside the Nashoba Road staging area has begun. Traffic controls were delivered and installed along Great Road as part of the approved traffic management plan for this project.
- During the week of March 10th, erosion controls were installed along the gravel access road leading from Breezy Point Road to the Nagog Pond dam gatehouse. Mobilization of equipment related to the stabilization of the gravel access road to be used for access to the Nagog Pond dam gatehouse has begun.
- Additional safety fencing is scheduled to be installed at the Nashoba Road staging area on Monday March 13th. Installation of the temporary access and barge assembly is anticipated to begin during the week of March 20th once the ice/slush on the pond is clear.

Permitting Activities

- On March 2nd the Acton Conservation Agent inspected erosion controls at the Nashoba Road staging area, per the September 2022 Order of Conditions. On March 9th the Acton Conservation Agent inspected erosion controls and road stabilization along the gravel access road leading to the Nagog Pond dam gatehouse.
- The Massachusetts Department of Transportation issued the permit for traffic management of this project at the intersection of Great Road (2A) and Nashoba Road.
- The Order of Conditions for the pond access supporting the intake replacement project was issued by Acton Conservation Commission to the Town of Concord on September 15, 2022, and was filed with Middlesex County South Registry of Deeds.
