Nagog Pond Project Update No. 22 – Week of August 4th

- The Nagog Pond Project is being constructed by the Town of Concord's General Contractor (D&C Construction Company of Weymouth, MA). Work is anticipated to continue through end of August 2023.

Construction Activities

- During the week of August 4th, D&C continued work inside the Nagog Pond Gatehouse. No work occurred on Friday August 4th.
- A final closeout inspection request was submitted to the Massachusetts Department of Transportation this week now that the staging/laydown area near the intersection of Great Road (2A) and Nashoba Road has been restored.
- No work is currently scheduled for next week (week of August 11th). Work is set to resume at the Nagog Pond Gatehouse later this month.

Permitting Activities

- The Massachusetts Department of Transportation permit for traffic management of this project is in the process of being closed out.
- The Order of Conditions for the pond access supporting the intake replacement project was issued by Acton Conservation Commission to the Town of Concord on September 15, 2022, and was filed with Middlesex County South Registry of Deeds.
