



Concord Public Works Curbside Collection Program

Concord's Curbside Collection Program for Solid Waste & Recycling is Changing!

Beginning in October of 2024, the Town will be changing to an automated curbside collection model with single stream recycling.

Each subscriber to the program will be issued a 35-gallon green Waste Management toter for solid waste and a 96-gallon green Waste Management toter with a yellow top for recycling.

****Please note-subscribers must have paid for their October-March subscription in order to receive their toters. Invoices will be mailed out in early September****



To manage occasional overflow trash, overflow tags will be able to be purchased for each additional 35-gallon bag.

Program highlights include:

- **Automated Collection:** It will reduce the program operational costs by increasing efficiency and will also result in newer trucks with better emissions on Concord roads.
- **Town-Issued 35-gallon solid waste and 96-gallon recycling carts:** They will be delivered to every subscriber.
- **Single-Stream Recycling:** Reduces the number of trucks needed for collection and reduces the overall carbon footprint of the program.
