What is the Connected Homes Program?

Connected Homes is a demand response program that leverages the technology of smart devices into cost savings for Concord Municipal Light Plant (CMLP) and its customers. It is a **voluntary** program that CMLP customers can take advantage of if they want to earn rewards for conserving energy.



How Does Connected Homes Work?

CMLP customers enroll smart devices into the program and Connected Homes makes brief, limited, adjustments to the devices during times of peak demand. This allows CMLP to better manage its demand and keep its rates low.



Which Devices are Eligible for Enrollment?

Select brands of Wi-Fi thermostats, residential batteries, electric vehicles and chargers, electric hot water heaters, and mini-split controllers are eligible for enrollment in Connected Homes. Visit www.NextZero.org/Concord for the full scope of devices.



How do Adjustments Occur?

Customers are notified in advance of adjustments via text and/or email. The number of adjustments per month may vary. Customers are rewarded quarterly via bill credits.
