Class 1 - \$100

Facilities/Businesses using and/or disposing of large amounts of hazardous materials; service stations w/ multiple gas pumps & facilities storing larger quantities of materials.

Class 2 - \$75

Facilities/Businesses such as smaller service stations, schools w/ laboratories or art studios, any type of treatment plant, art studios, furniture restoration, large dry cleaners, hardware stores storing large quantities of paints, solvents, etc.

Class 3 - \$50

Businesses such as supermarkets, hardware stores (minimal storage), farms, smaller scale dry cleaners.

Class 4 - \$25

Restaurants or establishments using at least (10) ten pounds or gallons of hazardous materials but pose only a minimal threat.

There are (4) four general categories of Hazardous Materials users with Class 1 posing the strongest threat of contamination and Class 4 posing the weakest threat. Some businesses (i.e. service stations, hardware stores, and/or farms) may fall into a higher- or lower-class dependent upon the amount of material stored or used.
